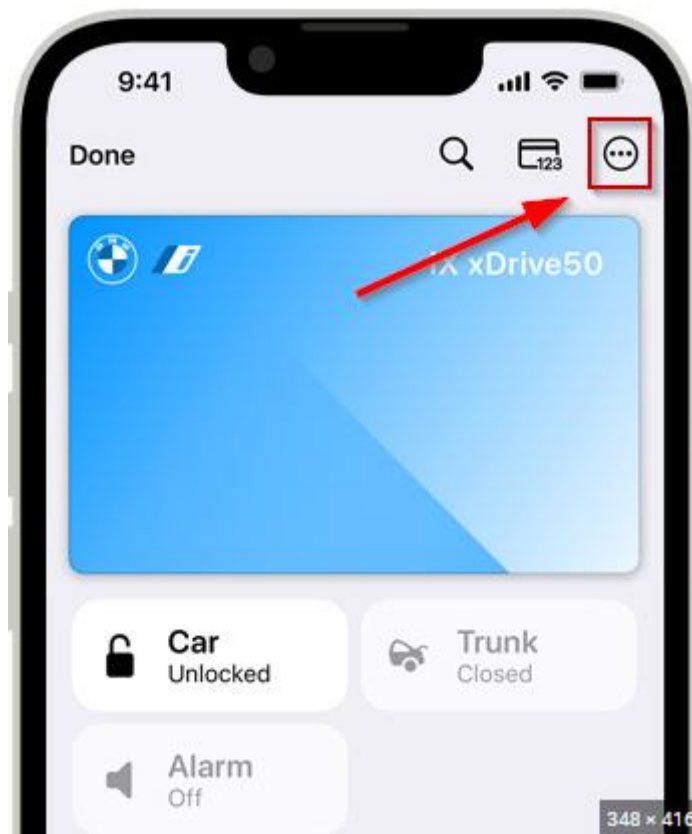


How to find your Apple Pay last 4 digits

All cards stored in Apple Pay are allocated a unique digital last 4 digits. This unique number ensures your payment information isn't stored on your device or shared with the merchant when making a payment. You can find your last 4 digits by opening the Wallet app, selecting your card and tapping the (...) symbol in the top right corner and pressing "card number".




How to find your Google Pay Virtual Account Numbers

A virtual account number is a type of temporary alias for your actual account number. A virtual account number is created when you add a card using the Google Pay app, Google Wallet app, or your banking app. For example, when you pay in stores:

- Your virtual account number is shared with the merchant.
- Your actual account number isn't shared. This helps to keep your account info safe.

To locate the virtual account number:

1. Open the Google Wallet app .
2. At the top, tap the payment card you used for the purchase.
 - You may have to swipe from right to left to find it, then tap the card.
3. At the bottom, tap **Details** > **Virtual account number**.
